

PRESIDENT MUSEVENI VISITS THE SOLAR SYSTEM AT RADIO PACIS

It is the first solar energy generation facility in Uganda to be connected to the grid. The solar park generates power that runs the equipment at Arua Diocese Media Centre and Radio Pacis. President Yoweri Museveni toured the facility on Monday 21 April 2014. The president was visibly impressed by what he saw.

The photovoltaic system actually provides electricity power that can be distributed by WENRECO to other customers in the community. The clean, affordable solar energy is not only environmentally friendly; it reduces operational costs at the radio and provides power for the community.

Director Fr Tonino Pasolini and Bishop Sabino Odoki were at hand to receive the president. The solar installation expert Frank Becker explained the technical connections to the president.

The staff lined up to wave to the president, who waved back at them. Onlookers gathered and watched as the president drove into Arua Diocese Media Center premises. ■
